

RULES

of the 21st Great Tenors Tournament in Szczecin

§ 1

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The 21st Great Tenors Tournament, hereinafter referred to as the Tournament, is organized by The Castle Opera in Szczecin on 29th of June 2019 in Szczecin.
2. In the Tournament may participate singers – tenors from all over the world, born after 30th of June 1979.
3. The Director of the Tournament is the Director of The Castle Opera in Szczecin, Jacek Jekiel. The Director of the Tournament will decide about any and all organizational matters related to the execution of the Tournament. Decisions of the Director of the Tournament are final and indisputable.

§ 2

APPLICATION AND QUALIFICATION FOR THE TOURNAMENT

1. Application for the Tournament shall be submitted on the application form until **20th of May 2019** and sent by e-mail to: kladczuk@opera.szczecin.pl The date of application receipt by The Castle Opera in Szczecin is decisive for the admission of the application. The application form is enclosed below as Annex no 1 to the Rules of the Tournament.
2. The application shall present the suggested repertoire, that is, three opera arias and three Italian or Neapolitan songs (or operetta arias), and specify the key of chosen works. In the course of the Tournament the Participant will be asked to perform one item of each category. The Director of the Tournament selects the performed work out of submitted suggestions. Additionally, after the contest performances, all the participants will jointly sing a Neapolitan song – *O sole mio*.
3. The following elements should be submitted with the application form:
 - a) A biography note (the course of the musical education, artistic achievements, the repertoire) – in Polish or English;
 - b) 2 current photographs (one portrait and one from the spectacle or concert) in an electronic version (a photograph of high resolution appropriate for printing – min. 300 dpi) to be used in press publications, in the Tournament program and on the website of The Castle Opera;
 - c) Video recordings (links to the Internet sites) presenting own performances given not earlier than within the last 2 years.

4. The Director of the Tournament will choose 8 participants out of all people applying for the Tournament on the basis of received recordings of applicants' artistic achievements. The participants will be informed about the qualification outcome by e-mail until **29th of May 2019**. The list of participants will be presented on www.opera.szczecin.pl.
5. The Organizer will conclude contracts for specific tasks with eight qualified candidates for the Tournament. The contracts will concern the applicants' preparation and artistic performance of works selected by the Director of the Tournament in compliance with the provisions of item 2 of the present paragraph, as well as the transfer of rights to the Organizer with regard to artistic performance within the exploitation fields specified in these contracts, and approval to use participants' image by the Organizer for the needs of organization and execution of the Tournament. The remuneration for performance, transfer of performance-related rights and approval to use the image shall amount to EUR 1.000,00 (in words: one thousand euro) gross or equivalent in PLN according to the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland of 25th of June 2019.
6. The participants declare that they will be available in the period from 26 June to 6 July 2019. The winner of the Tournament undertakes to participate in concerts organised as part of the Summer Opera Festival and in the preceding rehearsals; the rehearsals will be held on 2-4 July 2019, and the concerts will take place on 5,6 July 2019. The Opera will provide accommodation during the entire period of preparations and events. The remuneration for the participation in the rehearsals and concerts will amount to PLN 10.000,00. The detailed terms and conditions concerning the participation of the winner of the Tournament in the above-mentioned concerts will be specified in a separate agreement, and the winner of the tournament will be obliged to take part in such concerts on the specified date.

§ 3

COURSE OF THE TOURNAMENT

1. Participants of the Tournament shall be obliged to appear in Szczecin on 26th of June at 10 AM (venue: Opera na Zamku, ul. Korsarzy 34, Szczecin) and they shall be obliged to take part in promotional events, rehearsals as well as the concert according to the schedule provided below.
2. The schedule:
 - a) June 26th, 1 PM – press conference and a photo shoot for the Tournament (the venue will be indicated in the notice of qualification to the Tournament);
 - b) June 26th, 6-10 PM – musical rehearsal with orchestra;
 - c) June 27th, 6-10 PM – comprehensive rehearsal with the orchestra on stage (venue: Teatr Letni, Szczecin);
 - d) June 28th, 8:00 PM – dress rehearsal with the orchestra – Generalprobe (venue: Teatr Letni, Szczecin);
 - e) June 29th, 8:30 PM – 21st Great Tenors Tournament (venue: Teatr Letni, Szczecin);

The Director of the Tournament reserves the right to introduce changes in the present schedule.

3. In the course of the Tournament, participants will perform two works:
 - a) In the first part of the Tournament – an opera aria. The participant sings an opera aria with the orchestra of The Castle Opera, wearing a costume related to the character and lyrics of a given aria. The participant provides the costume on his own.
 - b) In the second part of the Tournament – an Italian or Neapolitan song (or an operetta aria). The participant sings a song or an operetta aria with the orchestra of The Castle Opera, wearing a tailcoat. The participant provides the tailcoat on his own.
4. Participants of the Tournament make their performances according to the order decided by a draw, which takes place during a press conference on 26th of June 2019.
5. Participants perform their repertoire from memory, in the original version.
6. The audience votes and selects the winner of the Tournament.
7. Every spectator will receive a red rose before the Tournament. The voting of the audience will consist in placing a rose in a basket marked with a given participant's number. The voting will start after all participants perform both works, and it will last 30 minutes. A protocol of the votes counting will be conducted.

§ 4

AWARDS

1. The main award of the Tournament is the audience award amounting to 20.000,00 PLN (in words: twenty thousands Polish Zlotys) gross and a title of the Winner of 21th Great Tenors Tournament.
2. The audience award will be handed in on the day of the Tournament after votes are counted and the Winner is announced.

§ 5

FINAL CONDITIONS

1. The Organizer shall return documented costs of travelling from the place of residence to Szczecin and from Szczecin to the place of residence to the amount of 200 euro.
2. The Organizer provides the accommodation during the Tournament.

3. All doubts related to the present Rules will be resolved according to the original Polish version.
4. Annex no 1 to the Rules constitutes the application form. Once the application form is signed and sent to the above-mentioned e-mail address, the applicant hereby accepts the present Rules.
